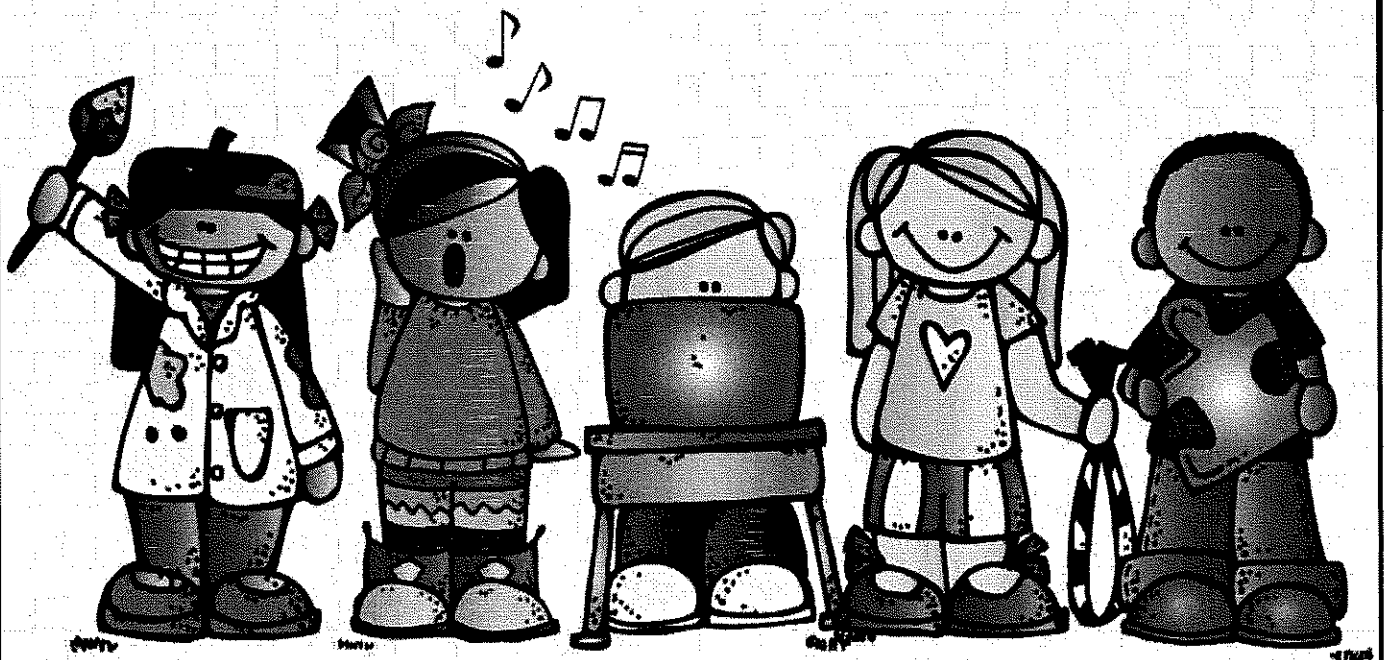

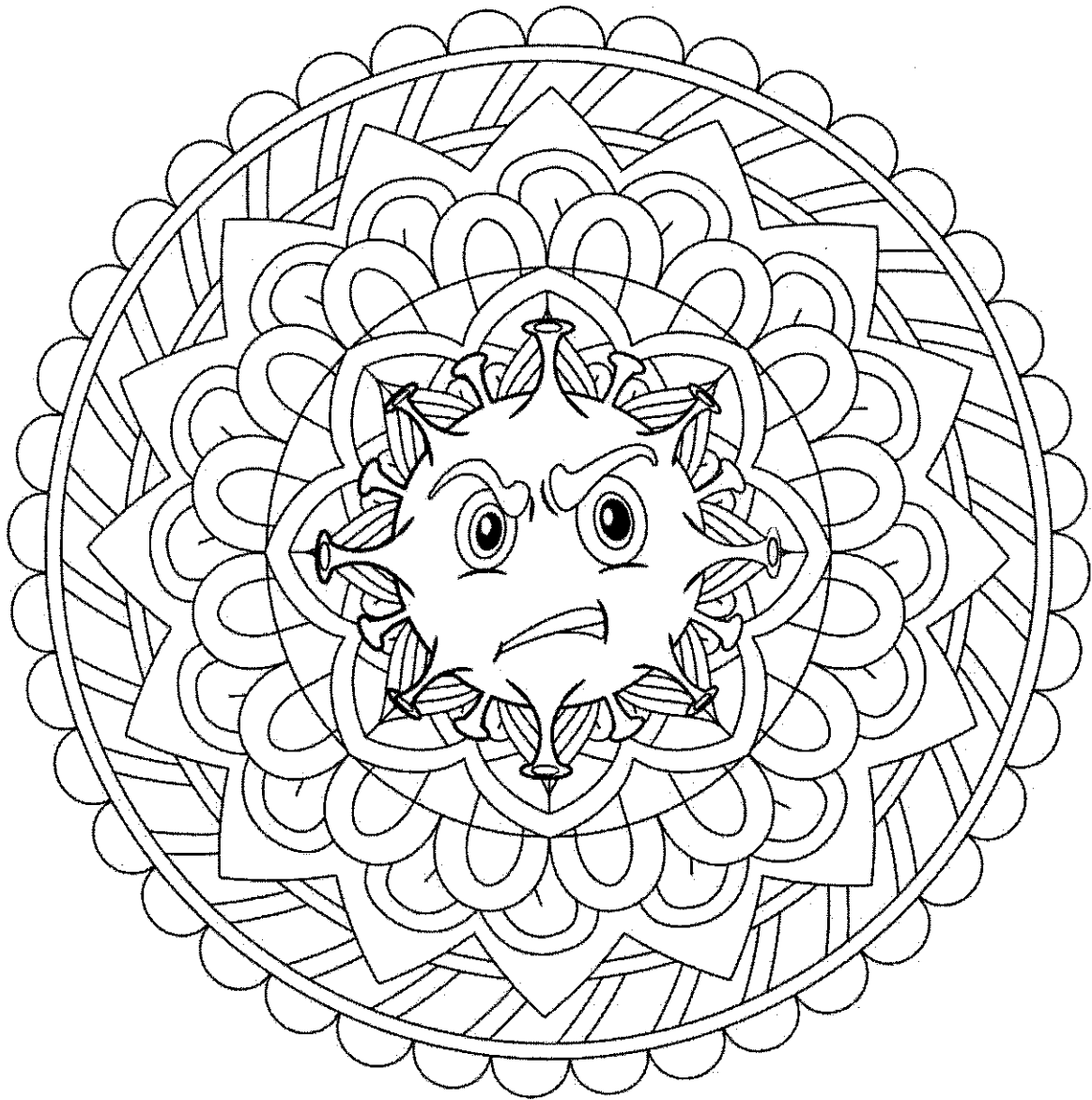

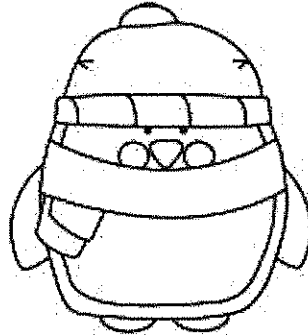

All About Penguins

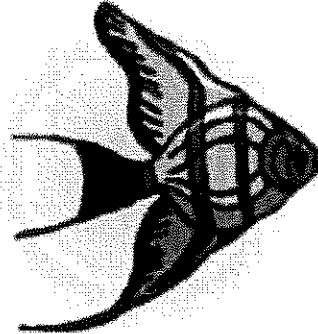

Finny has beautiful long fins that help her swim fast.



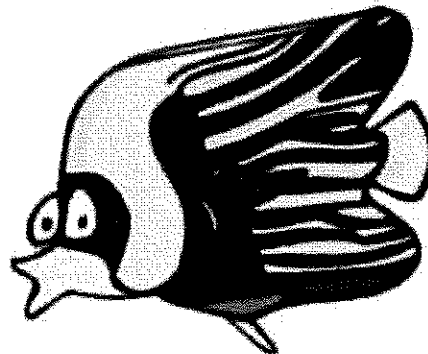
This is Tayla.

This is Igor.

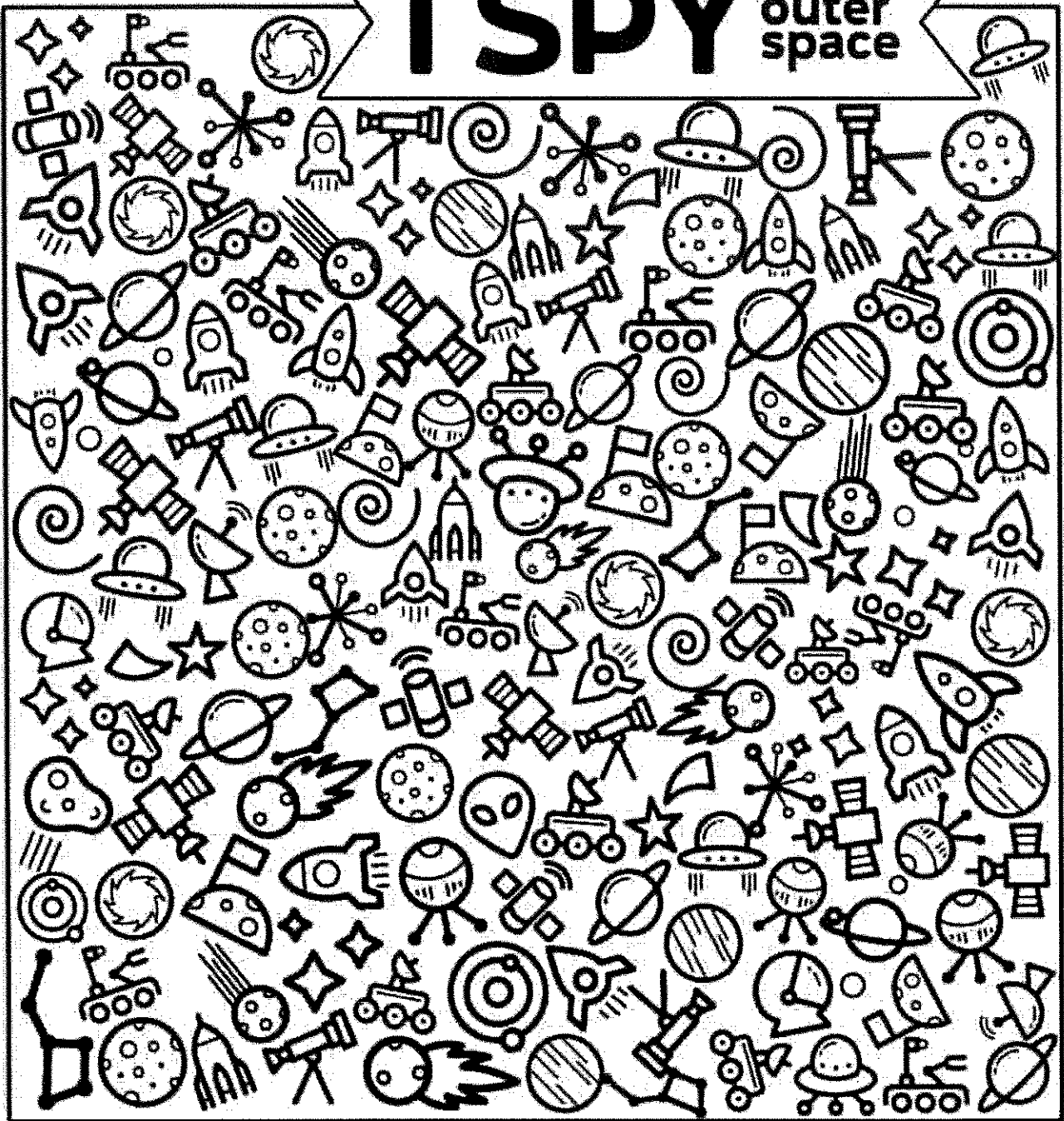
Igor has great big eyes. Igor's great big eyes help him to see where he is going and they also help him to see big scary fish!

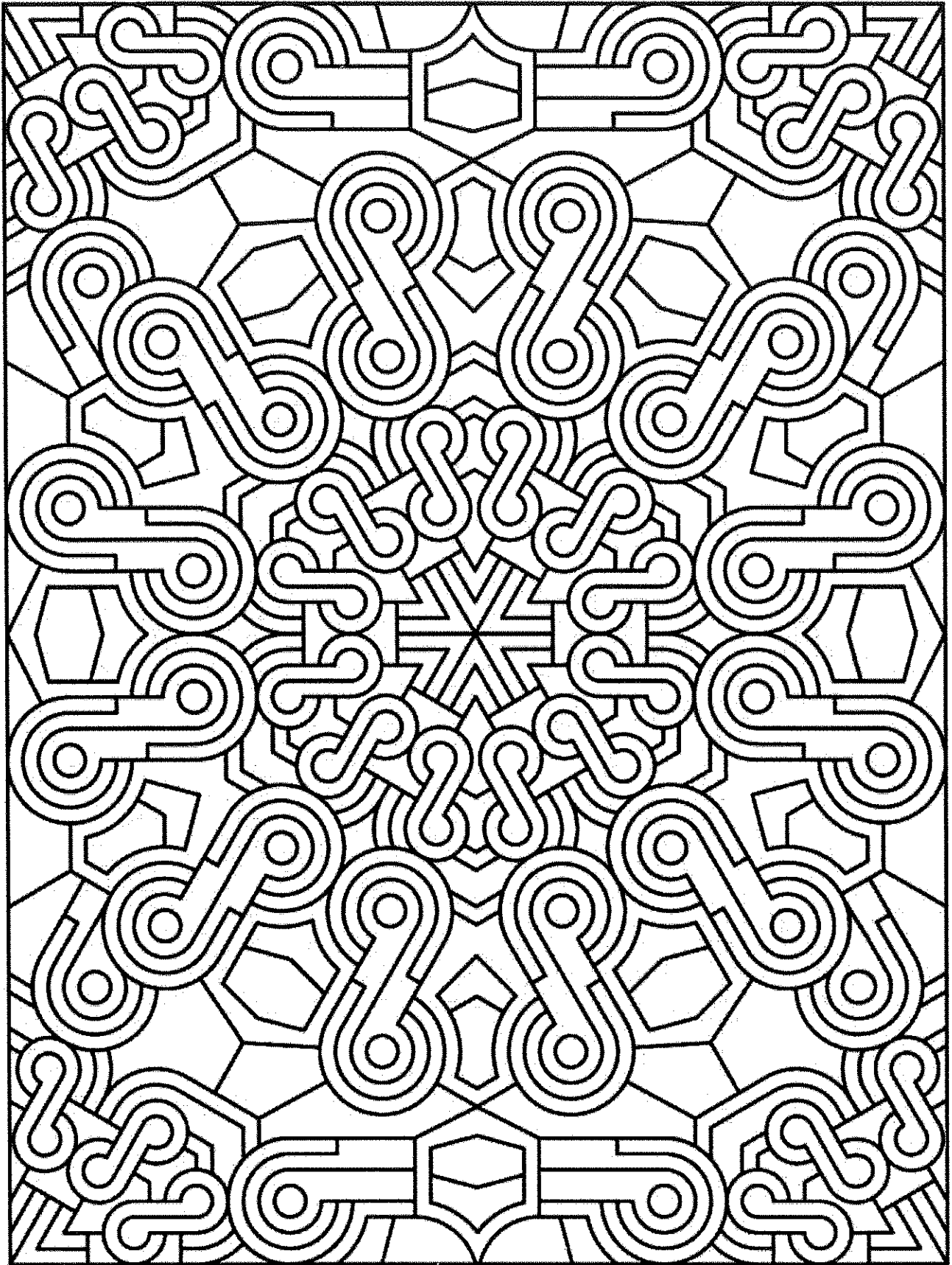
