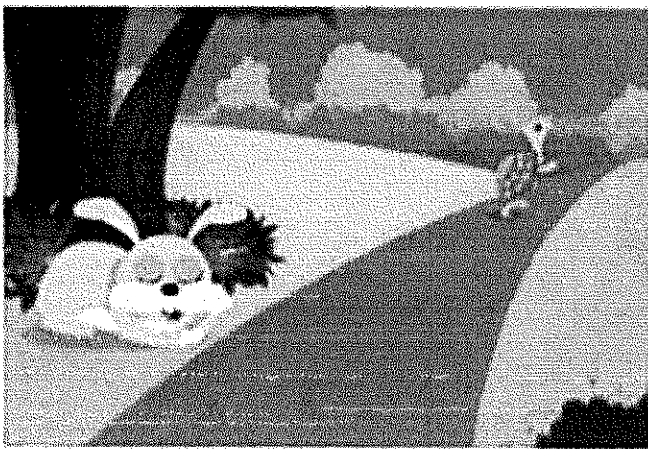
The Hare and the Tortoise

The Hare stretched himself out alongside the road and fell asleep, thinking, "There is plenty of time to relax."

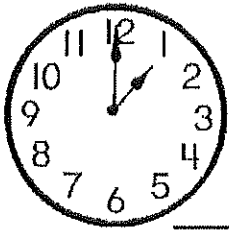
The Tortoise walked and walked; never ever stopping until he came to the finish line.

Rights and Responsibilities



Explanation:

- **Rights** – This can mean that you have the lawful **right to have something** or to **do something**. It means that if you have the right **to do something**, then it is law, and no one can stop you from doing it. If you have the right **to have something**, then it is the law that no one can prevent you from having it e.g. you have the right to education.
- **Responsibility** – This is your **commitment** that you must fulfill that goes with the rights that have been given to you e.g. You have the responsibility to do your homework which goes with the right that you have to education.

- Can you think of the responsibilities you have to **yourself and others**?

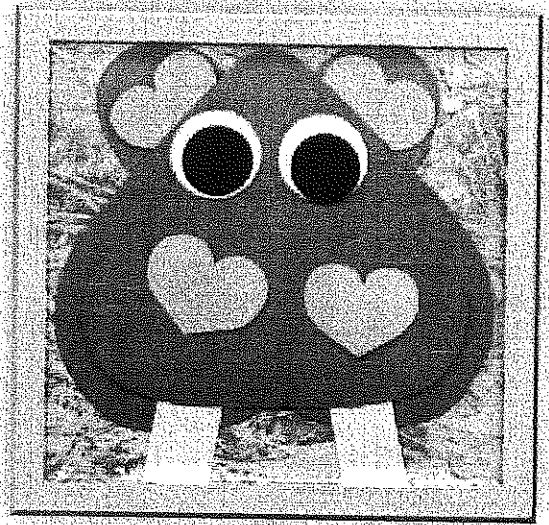
